**Sr. Mary Alice Haley, OSM**

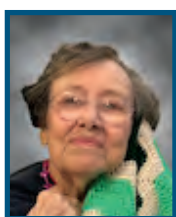
May 25, 1925 – February 8, 2020

Mary Alice (Sr. M. Donata) Haley was born on May 25, 1925 in Ogdensburg, NY. Sister entered the Servants of Mary on August 15, 1942. She made her first profession of vows in 1944 and final vows in 1949. Sister Mary Alice graduated with a Bachelor's Degree from Creighton University, and Master's and Doctorate in Philosophy from St. Louis University.

Sister began her teaching career in 1944 at Holy Ghost in Omaha, NE and then Servite High in Detroit, MI. She was a Professor of Philosophy at St. Louis University & Creighton University where she later became Chair of the Philosophy Department.

In 1981 Sister was elected as the Prioress General of the Servants of Mary of London/Cuves Congregation. She served two consecutive terms.

Her later years were filled with many friends and prayer/faith sharing groups. Sr. Mary Alice was known to say, "I think I will always be a philosopher at heart." Indeed, she was.



**Sr. Mary Louise Genest, OSM**

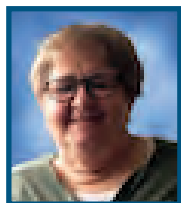
May 31, 1928 – January 6, 2020

Mary Rita Genest was born on May 31, 1928

in Rodman, NY. Sr. Louise entered the Servants of Mary on August 15, 1945. She made her first profession of vows in 1947 and final vows in 1952. She graduated with a Bachelor's Degree from Duchesne College in Omaha, NE and later earned a Master's Degree from Siena Heights in Adrian, MI.

She loved teaching and serving as a principal. Sr. Louise taught at St. Juliana's in Detroit, MI and Holy Ghost in Omaha, NE. She was one of the founding sisters of Christ the King School in Omaha, ministering as both a teacher and principal from 1954-1971.

She returned home to minister in Massena, New York at Sacred Heart and Trinity Schools, serving both as a teacher and principal for nearly forty years. Sr. Louise also ministered at the Servants of Mary Generalate in Rome, Italy from 1981-1983. Sr. Louise said this about her life, "Joy and peace. That's the way I've tried to live my life. It has been a joy and has brought me peace."



**Jan Saintmichael,**

**Associate**

April 17, 1945 – October 13, 2019

Jan Saintmichael was born April 17, 1945 just outside of Klamath Falls, OR. Jan majored in Art at U of O, Eugene, OR. She became a Servant of Mary Associate November 16, 1991. Jan first met the Servants of Mary at the Shrine of Our Sorrowful Mother/The Grotto in Portland, OR.

Jan was best defined by how she lived rather than the jobs she held. Holding many positions, some in manual labor, she came to realize that she could live out her call to compassionate presence



**Sr. Ann Moran, OSM**

February 22, 1944 – January 18, 2020

Dorothy Ann Moran was born on February 22, 1944 in Omaha, NE. Sr. Ann entered the Servants of Mary on September 8, 1962. She made her first profession of vows in 1964 and final vows in 1969. Sr. Ann graduated with a Bachelor's Degree from Duchesne College in Omaha, NE and later earned a Master's Degree from the University of Nebraska.

Sr. Ann's teaching career was based in Omaha, NE, ministering at St. Pius X/St. Leo and St. James Seton Schools. She was one of the founding teachers of St. Wenceslaus School in 1981 and continued to teach there until her retirement in January, 2019.

Sr. Ann was honored in 2003 as an Archdiocesan Teacher of the Year. In accepting this award, Ann said, "For me the search is for the hidden treasures in each student." In her teaching, Ann never wavered from this belief.



**Rosemary Holeman,**

**Associate**

March 27, 1939 – January 3, 2020

Rosemary Holeman was born March 27, 1939 in Chicago, IL. She became a Servant of Mary Associate on August 15, 1997. Rosemary first came to know the Servants of Mary as a student at Holy Name, Omaha, NE. She received her Bachelor's Degree from Duchesne College and later earned her MA at Loyola University, New Orleans.

Rosemary had a special love for children, especially those with special needs, refugees, and families in poverty. She worked endlessly providing support to these families through Holy Name School and Parish.

She volunteered for the Red Cross for a total of 60 years of service. She also volunteered for Camp Fire and Cub Scouts, Madonna School, Holy Name Parish, and St. Vincent de Paul Society.

She received the Presidential Citation in 2014 from the American Red Cross Overseas Association (ARCOA).

Through work, Jan met a Cuban refugee, Modesto, whom Jan mentored and became close friends. Later she was proud to play the role of grandmother to his children.

Jan's life was filled with fine arts. She loved many genres of music and was an artist in several mediums.

inclusive to any and all Sisters and Associates who would like to "attend" while also being stewards of your generous donations and not incurring a lot of travel related expenses. It will allow us to form tighter bonds with friends and family who will now be able to be a part of special events or Masses, such as our Jubilee Mass, wake services or funeral Masses.

## Servite Center of Compassion – Movies & Meaning

“Welcoming all with hope and compassion” is a phrase from the Mission Statement of the Servite Center of Compassion. One of the primary focuses at the Center is “healing and wellness.” When participants are welcomed and offered compassion and hope, this can be an experience of healing for individuals.

But we also wish to affect societal healing. One of the meaningful ways we do this is by regularly using movies, most often documentaries, to explore issues of justice. Movies draw viewers into the lives of those affected by injustice resulting in deeper empathy. When movies reveal the reasons and stories behind injustices, they increase understanding and therefore more effective response.

Over the years we have shown about 60 films on such varied topics as: refugees, human trafficking, sexism, climate crisis, racism, poverty, and stories of significant and inspiring leaders. The discussions that follow the viewings are always remarkable. Participants are knowledgeable, passionate, and caring.

A most recent film “Human Flow” is about the current global refugee crisis due to famine, poverty, violence, or natural disasters. This greatest human displacement since World War II, is captured by Director Ai Wei in a detailed and heartbreaking exploration. Movies truly are an available and meaningful way that we can become global citizens, caring about all our brothers and sisters who share this planet with us.

## Servants of Mary and Socially Responsible Investing

As a member of the Servants of Mary, US/Jamaica Community Financial Investment Committee, I’ve been asked to share some highlights with you, related to our commitment to socially responsible investing.

Our Community has a long-standing Socially Responsible Investment Policy that follows socially responsible investment guidelines and principles developed by the Interfaith Center for Corporate Responsibility. Following these guidelines and principles supports our desire to address root causes of injustice, uphold the dignity and rights of the human person, and protect the environment.

The Financial Investment Committee, composed of sisters and lay professionals, oversees our investments to ensure that we

support companies trying to positively impact people and the planet, while at the same time maintaining a secure financial base. Currently, about 10% of our investments are allocated specifically to initiatives on women investing in women, renewable energy and education.

We are committed to ongoing monitoring of our financial involvements to minimize exposure in areas that may threaten the stability of our world. This is a practical method of investment management for relatively small investors, such as the Servants of Mary, and will give us the opportunity to adjust and change investments as needed, in order to be fiscally responsible and to respond to the justice needs of our time.

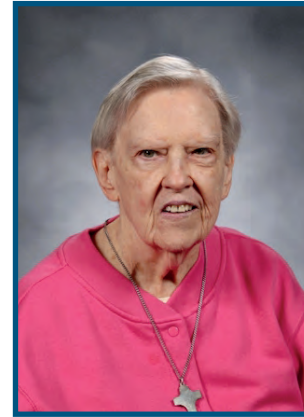

## Still Making a Difference

We are at this place in history because women religious stuck their necks out. Today, we celebrate the lives of Sr. Mary Hogan and Sr. Evangeline Wilkinson as they celebrate 70 years of religious life as Servants of Mary.

Sr. Mary began her ministry as a teacher. And like so many before her, spent hours preparing her lesson plans only to realize the plan took only 30 minutes to teach. In time, she mastered teaching and went on in later years to work in the area of spiritual direction, and social justice. Mary would not call herself brave but that is the only word that comes to mind when she recounts marching in Selma in 1965.

Today Sr. Mary remains committed to a ministry of prayer. She says, "It may not sound exciting, but it is quiet, real and forceful. It is a personal relationship with God."



Sr. Evangeline loved teaching and quickly excelled at it. In addition to being a Master teacher, she too recognized a need in our Church and society. She began two organizations that today we just expect to exist. The first was to establish and direct a Head Start Program here in the Omaha area. The second was the creation of a Family Life Office in various dioceses. These organizations are now integral to our Church, society and educational system.

Today Sr. Evangeline is also committed to a life of prayer. She states that her prayer, "is the most important thing in her life. It is all about supporting people."

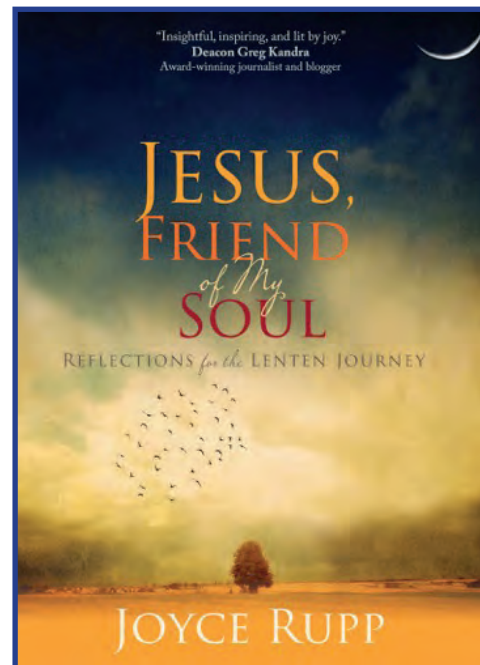

## Spiritual Reflection

Have you ever heard someone express that they like Advent better than Lent? For many Advent seems never to last long enough and Lent seems to last forever. I admit that I have been one of those people. Advent seems to offer hope, joy and promise – “God with us.” Lenten reflections, on the other hand, emphasize sacrifice, and the cost of discipleship, of self-gift – “If any want to become my followers, let them deny themselves and take up their cross daily and follow me” - Luke 9:23. Of course, in living the Paschal Mystery we also recognize the hope, joy and promise of new life offered through the resurrection. For sure the paths converge, but one path seems to provide an easier journey than the other.

Two recent publications: *The Universal Christ*, by Richard Rohr, and *Jesus, Friend of My Soul*, by Joyce Rupp, have inspired me to look at Lent in a whole new way. What if I anticipated the Lenten season as an opportunity to focus exclusively on my relationship with Jesus Christ? Richard Rohr expands, deepens, and challenges my knowledge of Jesus. Joyce Rupp provides a day by day reflection, based on a passage from scripture, on how to live life patterned on the life Jesus lived. Joyce states, “His life bore fruit because he continuously gave open-heartedly of himself.” I am asking myself if I can “open- heartedly” give of myself and become more like him. If I take it seriously, six weeks won't be long enough.
