# Letter from Sr. Jackie Ryan

Dear Friends,

Last year I participated in a workshop attended by over five hundred women religious across the country. One of the speakers reminded us that we are on "a journey we would not have chosen, but have been invited by the Spirit to take."

Each of us, at different times in our lives, can identify with these words. Life events such as a loss of job, an illness, a sudden death, a move to a care facility and many other unexpected happenings have entered our lives without our choosing. We have all been there. And in hindsight, we have all found ways to survive and eventually thrive.

As you may know, the Servants of Mary sold our Motherhouse and property to Marian High School in 2019. In the agreement, Marian stated that we may remain in the Motherhouse as long as we choose. One of the tasks before us is to determine when and how this transition will unfold.

In order to begin planning for this new journey, with new ways of living community, all of our sisters met together during the summer of 2022 to begin praying, dialoguing and processing how this eventual move from the Motherhouse will affect our community life and our ministries as we move forward. In addition, we have established an Exploring Future Community Living Committee. Members of the Committee have met individually with each sister, provided opportunities for prayer and faith sharing, met regularly with the Marian Administration and Board of Directors and hired consultants from the Religious Institute Division of Plante Moran, an international consulting and investment firm.

The Marian administration is also moving forward. They have hired an architectural firm to do a full site and facility master plan of the Marian campus, including the Motherhouse.

Even though much planning lies ahead, I wanted to share this stage of the journey with you, our families and friends. As we move forward, we promise to keep you updated.

In the meantime, let us continue to journey together with compassion and hope, believing God walks with each of us.

Thank you for your support and let us continue to remember one another in prayer.




# Graduate of Boundless Compassion Facilitator Program Spreads the Message

# Obituaries



### Sr Terese Lux, OSM

December 12, 1930–June 8, 2023

Sister (Clara) Terese was born in Shelby, NE to Clara and Herman Lux. She was the youngest of six. Her siblings have all preceded her in death.

Sr. Terese took a leap of trust on August 30, 1949. Her leap of trust was entering the Servants of Mary Community without knowing any of the sisters. Later she would become the Prioress Provincial of the Servants of Mary.

Sr. Terese dedicated herself to a variety of ministries. She taught at six grade schools in Nebraska, Iowa and New York. Her first work in administration began at Marian High School as the Assistant Principal. Sister continued in administration at the College of St. Mary, Omaha, NE, both as Vice President of Students and Assistant Dean of Students.

Sr. Terese loved education and research. In 1980, she returned to school to receive her PhD in Community and Human Development Resources. After receiving her PhD, she began her own business, DeLuxe Programs. She was a nationally known seminar leader, group facilitator and adult educator.

After retiring from education, Sister went on to volunteer in jail ministry, at Jesuit Middle School and Essential Pregnancy Services.

Sister Terese is survived by many nieces and nephews and her Servite Family.



## Sr Iris (M. Gerald) Deprez, OSM

July 28, 1931—May 18, 2023

Sister Iris was originally from Detroit, MI and grew up in St. Juliana Parish. Sr. Iris was one of four children, born to Gerald and Dorothy (McKenzie) Deprez.

She entered the Servants of Mary in 1949. Sr. Iris served in a variety of ministries including teaching kindergarten and grades one through high school. She taught in Omaha, NE, Massena, NY, Detroit, MI, Denver, Arvada, Englewood, Aurora, Westminster, and Colorado Springs in CO.

Sr. Iris' most treasured ministry was adult faith formation. It was the time of the Second Vatican Council, and her goal was to help people have a loving relationship with God through a clearer understanding of doctrine, scripture and their own adult spirituality. She was an excellent teacher, and had many pastoral gifts as well.

Sr. Iris also ministered for the Community as a Motherhouse Coordinator and Development Director.

Known for her love of the outdoors, she enjoyed fishing and hiking during her many years in Colorado.

She is survived her brother Bernie, sister-in-law Charlotte and many nieces and nephews and her Servite Family.

## Barbara Favor

November 13, 1942–May 22, 2023

Known as a prayer warrior, Barbara Favor became a Servants of Mary Associate September 15, 2004. She was proud to be a native of Tucson, a city filled with snowbirds.

Barbara enlisted in the U.S. Army Women Corp. and served a three-year tour. She retired from the U.S. Geological Survey Services after thirty years of dedication.

She was married to Charles Favor for 47 years until his death in 2011.

She is survived by her daughter, Catherine Benavidaz of Tucson and her son Phillip Favor (Natasha) and her grandchildren, Carson and Gwendolyn. She is also survived by her brother Mario Gonzalez, who provided care for her in the last months of her life.

Barbara was very active as an Associate of the Servants of Mary for many years. She enjoyed her volunteer work with St. Vincent de Paul and shared in any way she could in her parish, Our Mother of Sorrows.


